ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT 2017 - 2018

Access from school to the playground is possible using the ramps either via Class 1 or via the staffroom (Conservatory). The main doors into school and the Conservatory outside door have threshold step which are low and wheeled items can be lifted.

All internal doors and to the outside are wide enough to accommodate a wheelchair.

Access to the toilets from playground is difficult because of steps but is possible by another route. There is a disabled toilet large enough to accommodate a wheelchair. It includes a handrail.

In the event of a pupil being admitted to school with particular accessibility needs, we have been informed that the Local Authority would give advice and assist in making provision.

- Generally there is level access throughout school.
- The toilets and conservatory areas are of newer build and accessible within school.
- The flooring is even.
- Internal doors are a good width
- Village Hall – P.E. takes place here at times when we require indoor space. Access includes a ramp and a disabled toilet.
- Playground – P.E. takes place on Tiger Turf surface-reduces risk of injuries and is non-slip.
- The Local Authority can provide suitable transport for swimming sessions, which take place in the Spring Term.
- Self-closing fire doors in school are held open with Dorgard devices that will close automatically in the event of a fire.
