In science we continued our enquiries into healthy lifestyles by looking at exercise. The year 1s wore pedometers to measure their steps and compared ways of moving to cover distance in the fastest time possible.

After the trip to Cosford the children wrote their recounts with lots of details of favourite parts of the day. Our plane role play has enabled them to relive some of these experiences. Our tuff tray is a Chinese restaurant this week.

In maths reception have been exploring number 9 and looking at the relationship to the number 10 using bead strings and ten frames. Year 1s have looked at using the 'plus' sign.

Class 2 thoroughly enjoyed their trip to Cosford. The children role played going on holiday on a plane and had the opportunity to became air stewards and pilots. Then we experienced 'Fun 'n flight', learning about gravity and how to steer a plane. Next we made parachutes and helicopters and tested them. Finally we walked around the Cold War Museum looking at all the old planes and vehicles. Back in school the children recounted their trip and their favourite parts.

In maths the year 1 children have completed their addition and subtraction of multiples of 10 and year 2 have started their new topic multiplication and have discussed equal and unequal groups.
