CLASS 1

The children have learned about the Wright brothers being the first to fly a plane with an engine . We will plot the events on a time line to show the chronological order .

In maths the class have celebrated 100 days in school. We have been recording our days using ten frames, tally charts, number line and a 100 square. We wrote cards to each other, exercised in 100 second blocks, had lots of games and a big platter of fruit.

In science the children will be looking at the local environment in the winter season and looking for signs of spring.



CLASS 2

This week Class 2 have been working hard on their maths skills. Year 2 have been reasoning about groups and discussing how multiplication statements can match addition calculations and images. Year 1 have been securing their knowledge of numbers to 100 and their position in a number square and on a number line. In English the children have used powerful verbs to describe action and have made fantastic predictions for what might happen next in the adventure. The children who went to the gymnastic event had a wonderful afternoon and tried many different skills including moving along the bar and balancing on a high beam. The children who stayed in school organised an amazing afternoon of sporting activities focusing on skills like dribbling, sprinting and jumping. In RE we have been looking at the religion Islam and the importance of the mosque.
