CLASS 1

We had a special assembly on Friday for Reception parents to celebrate them joining our school.

In maths lessons reception have been learning the numbers 1,2,3 in lots of practical ways. Year 1s have been counting forwards and backwards and finding the number 1 more. Class 1 made rocket models to help them to count backwards. We tested the models that flew best and adapted them.

CLASS 2

Class 2 have worked very hard this week exploring place value of number. The year one children have explored the value of number, the sequence and the different ways we can make 5. In year two we have investigated two digit numbers, focusing on the value of the tens and units digits and how we can partition the two digit numbers in different ways. In English we have now finished looking at our book Dogger by writing our own version of the story and I am proud to say we have many budding authors in Class 2! The children also picked runner beans and yellow and red tomatoes from the garden.



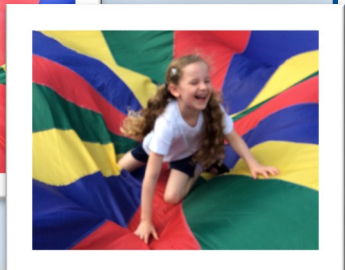
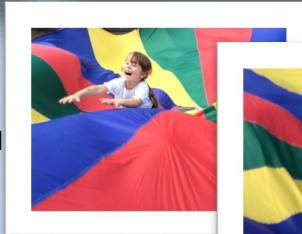
Green Beans
