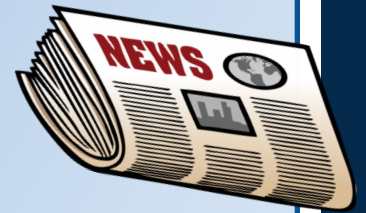

GOODBYE MRS WILLIAMS

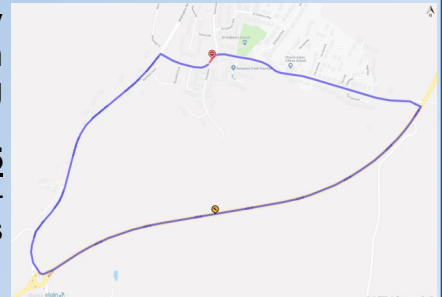
We said goodbye and good luck to Mrs Williams in a special assembly on Monday 17th September. Children had made her a beautiful felt picture and some lovely cards.

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Just a reminder of the following deadlines:

- Applying for primary school places to start in September 2019 (starting school for the first time) - **closing date 15 January 2019**
- Applying for infant to junior school places to start in September 2019 (current Year 2 pupils) - **closing date 15 January 2019**
- If a child has an Education, Health & Care Plan the closing date is 31st October 2018 for all applications.
