#### O TRACK

Due to current GDPR legislation we wanted to let you know that we are continuing to use a system called O Track. O Track is an assessment tool which helps us to track progress and attainment of children's learning.

To use this system we upload information about your child to O Track, this information includes some personal information including their name, DoB, gender, country of birth, pupil number, nationality, ethnicity, first language, service child, disability, enrolment status etc along with their assessment history for example their EYFS data where available.

O Track is compliant with GDPR legislation, all of their processes and technologies are documented and compliant with GDPR.
