Class 1 started the week making cakes and decorating them. They went on to writing the instructions using imperative (bossy) verbs.

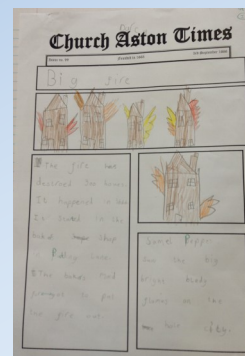
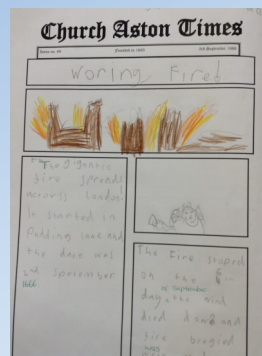
In maths the children were telling addition stories using the words First, then now to explain how the numbers were increasing.

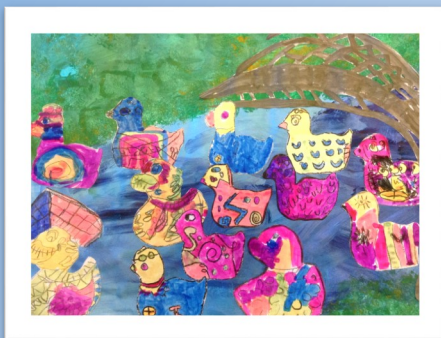
