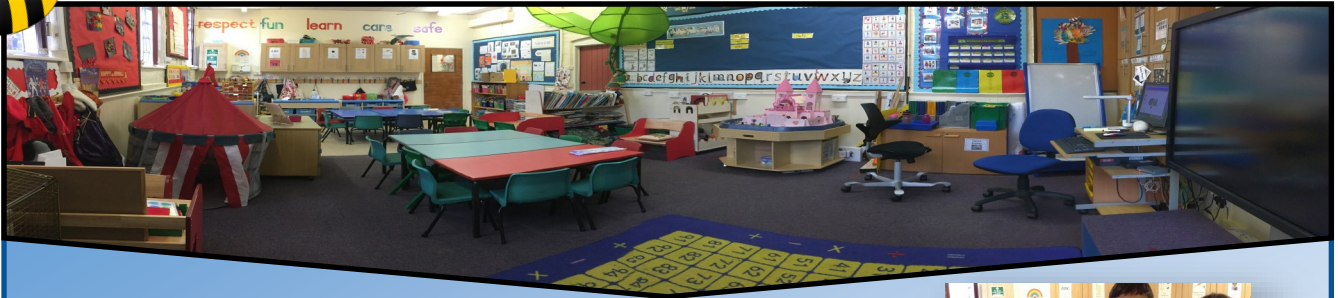

CLASS 1

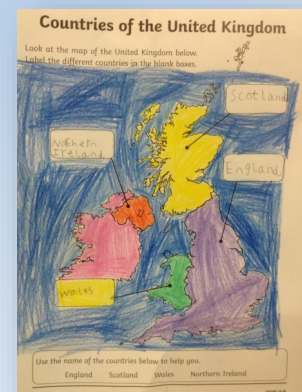

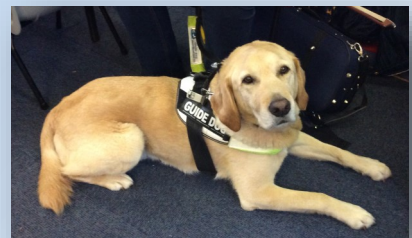


CHRISTMAS CHOIR TIME FOR CLASS 2
