SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

The online admissions application process is now available at www.telford.gov.uk/admissions.

The following deadlines apply this year:

- Applying for Reception Year school places to start in September 2022 (starting school for the first time) - closing date 15 January 2022
- Applying for Infant to Junior school (Year 2 into Year 3) places to start in September 2022 (current Year 2 pupils) - closing date 15 January 2022
- If a child has an Education, Health & Care Plan the closing date is 31st October 2021 for all applications.

Class 1 have been busy with their maths this week. In Year 1 the children have been investigating different ways of partitioning numbers 6 to 10 whilst in Reception the children have been looking at how they can make the numbers 3 and 4.

CLASS 1

The children have really enjoyed making different types of furniture for the inside of a house, they had lots of fun using a range of materials to make all sorts of models including tables, chairs, and lamps.

Their RE session involved an interesting discussion looking at artifacts and photographs which encouraged them to talk about how different people celebrate.

During their writing session Year 1 children were very focused on their use of capital letters and full stops. Reception children are really getting to grips with listening to all the sounds in cvc words and then writing them.
