






CLASS 1

In maths reception have been looking at two and three object repeating patterns.



In maths the year 1 children have been finding the missing number using their knowledge of a difference of one. They have explored this using different representations including a number line and part part whole models.

In Geography the children learned about prepositions, e.g. in, on, next to etc.

Have a nice, relaxing week off and we will see you after half term.




CLASS 2




In Maths the Year 1 children have been finding the missing number using their knowledge of a difference of one. They have explored this using different representations including a number line and part part whole models.

Rewarded for being a kind and caring member of the class.


