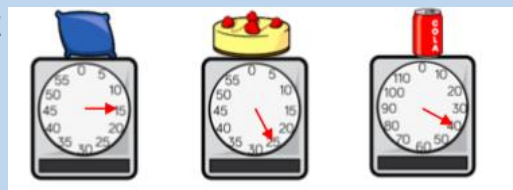
CLASS 2



What an exciting term we've had!

This week Class 2 have beautifully rewritten the story of Duffy's Lucky Escape. The children used verbs, adverbs and adjectives to describe the journey Duffy went on. Due to the topic of the story, it allowed Class 2 to look at ways we can stop plastic from polluting our oceans. The children all wrote a letter to Greenpeace asking for help to stop the pollution of plastic and asked for ways they could help. Class 2 have had a successful week in English with beautiful handwriting and fantastic use of punctuation.

Year 2 delved into the topic of weight specifically measurement in grams. The children were able to look at a scale and write the correct measurement using the g symbol for grams.



A challenge for everyone in Class 2 is to bake and send in pictures of you reading the scale and writing down the correct measurement of the ingredients you are weighing out. I look forward to seeing all the pictures of what you have made. I wonder how many two and three digit numbers you will see?



On Monday Class 2 participated in a fantastic gymnastics lesson, where the children were set the challenge of working in groups to create and obstacle course making bridges, planks and crab shape with their bodies that they had to manoeuvre around. All the children were successful in this activity and had fun while doing so.
