Dear Parents and Carers

What a full week we have had in school! I am sure that Year 1 and 2 children are getting back into the school routine now. For Reception children, you may find that they have been tired this week as they get used to full days. This will ease, I promise you.

There has been plenty of new learning happening this week. Our main focuses have been learning about where we live, our country, continent and world. Class 2 have learnt a song to help them remember the continents, check out their page below for the link to it. In science the children are securing naming body parts and looking at how animals grow and change, including humans.

In assembly on Monday I launched our new Jigsaw piece, thinking about kindness and how we treat each other. This has linked well with RE work on respect and understanding what that means.

Class 1 children have continued to get to know each better through play activities and went over to visit the village hall in preparation for PE there on Fridays. In maths the Reception children have been working on growing numbers to 3 using their fingers, whilst Year 1 have been making comparisons between amount, height and mass. One challenge I have been giving the children this week is to use a knife and fork to cut up food whilst eating. When prompted the children are managing well as you can see, but practising this at home would really benefit their independent skills.
