We are now over halfway through this half term. Mrs Powell looked at Autumnal changes in assembly this week and we are encouraging the children to be on the lookout for beautiful leaves and autumn objects that they would like to bring in and share.

Class 2 have created some stunning artwork this week, drawing leaves using different marks to fill in the areas. They have also been exploring how to create lines and patterns on the iPads using a painting app.

Class 1 have been exploring their senses of taste, touch, smell, hearing and sight this week. They have talked about the parts of the body they use for each of these senses and went on a senses walk around the playground. Mrs Bundy and Mrs Harris were amazed at how much they noticed!

Over the last week both classes have been involved in voting for School Council members. 
