Dear Parents and Carers

We have had a delightful week back in school and the children have been excited to see their friends again.

Year 1 Class 1 children have been working on writing recounts. They started by writing about their week off last week and are now progressing to writing funny recounts and using the prefix 'un'. Reception children are continuing to build on their sentence writing and writing for a purpose.

Year 2 have been working hard on calculating skills with two 2-digit numbers. This involves partitioning into tens and ones as a strategy to aid calculations. I have also seen some wonderful writing from Class 2 Year 1s recalling the story of 'Greta and the Giants'. Their enthusiasm and stamina for writing at length has really come on.

This week has also seen plenty of phonics and reading practise going on. Next week we will be carrying the national phonic screening assessment for all Year 1 children. It will really help if you could encourage your children to practise their reading and phonics at home in preparation. We will be reporting the results of this assessment in your children's reports at the beginning of July.

On Monday next week we have representatives from Newport Girls High School and Newport Hockey Club coming in for the afternoon to give the children a taster session of what happens in the club. Please ensure that your children are wearing PE kit on Monday ready for the event. If your child would like to become involved in the hockey club, please see the adverts in this newsletter.

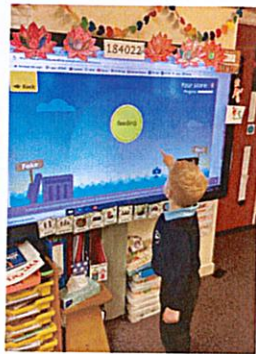

Carnival Workshop has been cancelled.

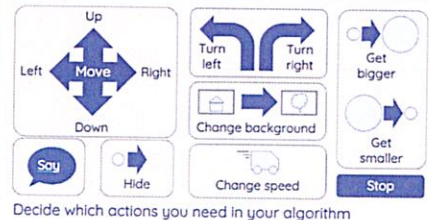
CLASS 1

Shuffle up day where Year 2 children going to Moorfield will spend the day in their new school.

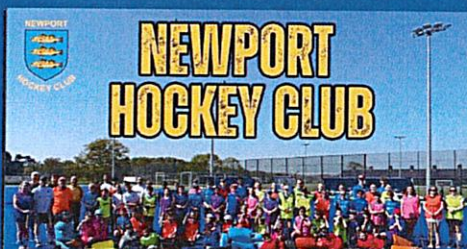

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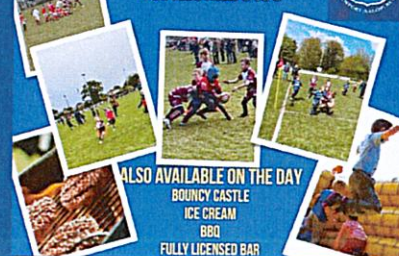

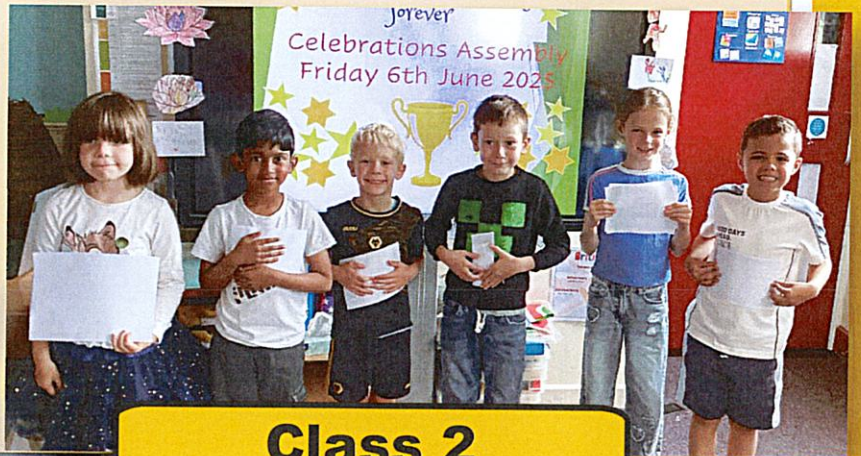
