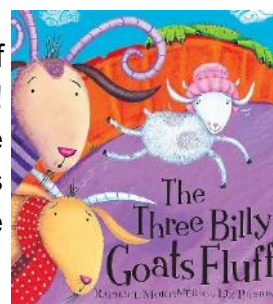


CLASS 1

Have a great weekend and we will see you all next week.



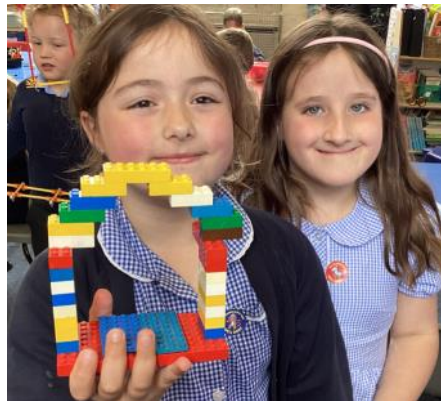

Class 2 have gone bridge crazy this week!



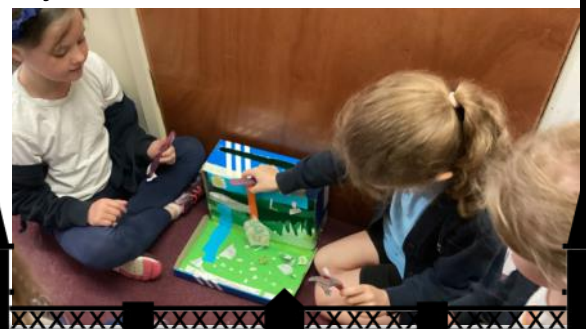
The children have been continuing their learning about our local World Heritage site, the famous

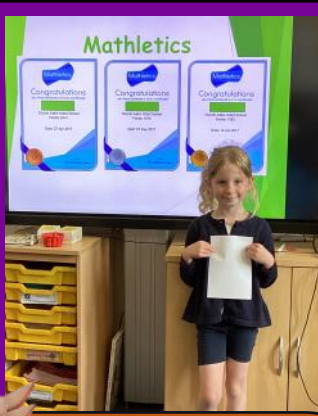
