Punctuality - lost learning - <mark>54 minutes</mark>

Dear Parents and Carers

It's been another busy week! Both classes have made the most of the dry weather with Reception enjoying some dressing up and building on the playground. Whilst teams from Class 2 have been exploring the effects of exercise on their bodies to stay healthy – there were lots of hot and thirsty children!



Our science work on body parts has continued across school and is moving into specific body parts for senses and exploring more around the life cycles of animals. Class 2 have been particularly interested in one animal, Cinnamon the capybara. They have created missing posters as part of their written work.

In Class 1 written work has focused on the story 'All are Welcome'. They have been thinking about how everyone is different, exploring feelings and

comparing the school day in the book to our school day. Children have written about what makes them happy in school and written lists of activities that they do.

In maths this week work has continued on number, with children adding different numbers to make the same total and using their knowledge of number bonds to help them. Reception children have been focusing on cardinality, that is knowing that when they count, the last number they say gives the total. This work has also included counting things they can't see, such as claps and sounds. See the photos below to see how they got on.

Our Friends of School held a successful meeting this week and welcomed some of our new parents. Events have been planned for this term so keep an eye out on the diary dates for upcoming events. If you couldn't make the meeting but would still like to offer support, please speak to myself or email the office.

Following the new guidance on attendance we are now keeping a record of punctuality. No fines are issued for this, however being late does impact on children, leading them to feel embarrassed about coming in late and missing the beginning of lessons. 
