Dear Parents and Carers

We started this week thinking about British Values. We are using our hands to help us remember the five values. Last term we learnt about democracy and use our thumb to represent voting. This week we thought about the Rule of Law and using our index finger to remind us about fairness.



At the start of the week, Class 2 listened to the story of the Penguin Who Wanted to Fly. The children were so inspired by the story that they went on to write their own versions of it. I've even read some stories that children wrote at home or in Breakfast Club! As part of this work the children learnt that an emperor penguin is about the size of a 7-year-old. As a result, they worked in pairs to draw around one another and create giant penguins which are decorating the school.

Class 1 enjoyed a visit from Mrs Perry, our music teacher, on Tuesday. The focus of their lesson this week was tempo, and the children used different percussion instruments to explore playing fast or slow to songs and music. They also talked about keeping a steady beat when playing along.



Swimming finished for Class 2 this week. They had a surprise float party which the children absolutely loved. Mrs Powell and the staff are so proud of the progress the children have made over the 5 weeks. Class 1 start their swimming lessons next week. Mrs Bundy has asked that Class 1 children come to school in their PE kits (joggers) on Wednesdays to help with changing.
