Our science work this week has been all about plants. Children have been naming parts of a plant, planting seeds and experimenting with what seeds need to germinate. Have a look at the class page below. This week we have started our new history topic around The Great Fire of London. 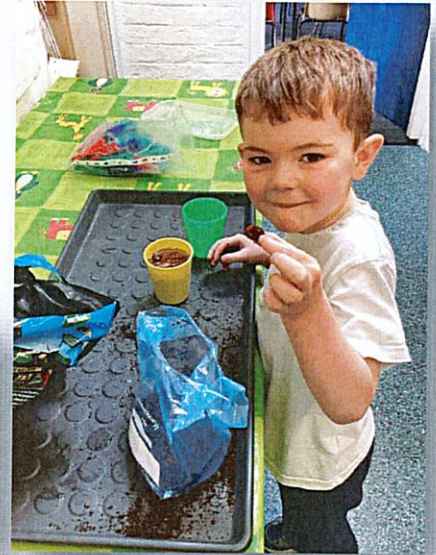

# CLASS 2

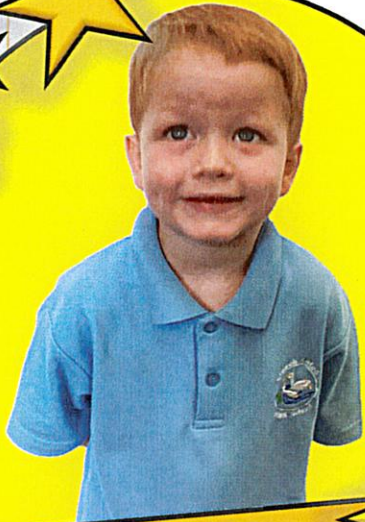
