Reception children created Artwork based on the Great fire of London.

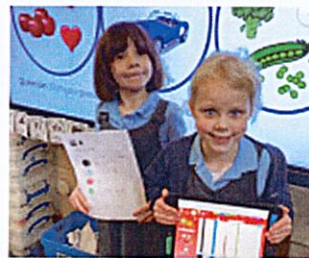


CLASS 2

Once the tally chart was complete they then used the data to create a pictogram



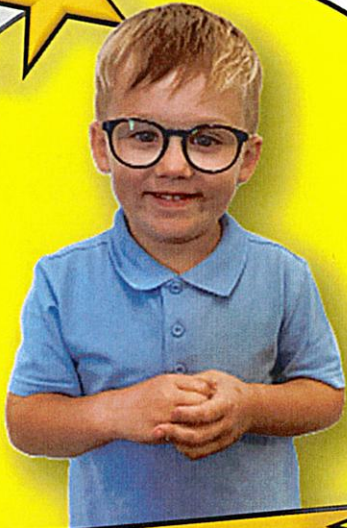
