

Principles of Behaviour

Church Aston Infant School promotes high expectations of behaviour to support our children in their learning. Children, staff and visitors have the right to feel safe, valued and respected. Our school is inclusive and all pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.

Our children are taught the expected behaviour and school rules. Our values of fun, care, safe, respect and learn are reflected throughout the school day and in all school learning and activities.

Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to children at all times. Rewards and sanctions are known, understood and used consistently by staff, in line with our school's behaviour policy. Children understand the school rules and are supported in developing self-regulation and responsibility for their actions. There are a wide range of rewards, consistently and fairly applied in such a way to reward good behaviour. It is recognised that the use of rewards and sanctions must have regard to the individual situation and the individual child and the Headteacher and staff are expected to use their discretion.

We aim to foster strong relationships between school and families to gain an understanding of the whole child and how best to support them both in school and at home. Consideration will be given to a wide range of support, including external services.
